Worcester Public Library to Host Major Digital Equity Announcement Event

WORCESTER, Mass. – Worcester Public Library (WPL) is proud to announce that it has been awarded 500 Chromebooks through the Connected and Online Program, a statewide initiative led by the Massachusetts Broadband Institute (MBI), a division of the Massachusetts Technology Collaborative (MassTech).
